



International 420 Class NSW Championship 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday 24th – Sunday 25th April

1 Organising Authority and Venue

The organising authority and venue for the regatta is Woollahra Sailing Club, Vickery Avenue, Rose Bay.

2 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012) including the special regulations and prescriptions of Yachting Australia and the International 420 Class Association Rules.

3 Alteration of Racing Rules

Rule 42 is changed such that the Race Committee may permit pumping, ooching and rocking when the consistent wind exceeds 13knots in accordance with Class Rules by making the appropriate signal (to be detailed in the Sailing Instructions) at or before the warning signal or at a mark of the course.

4 Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International 420 Class that fulfill the following requirements:

- a) Each shall be a member of a club affiliated with their respective State Yachting Association. Attention is drawn to RRS 46 and 55.
- b) Each entrant shall be a financial member of the NSW 420 Class Association or of the 420 Class Association of another state.
- c) **Interim membership:** If required, a fee of \$50 per sailor, allows single event membership of the class association for this regatta.
- d) Each boat shall comply with the International 420 Class Rules. There will be no measurement at registration however the race committee reserves the right to conduct spot checks.

7.2 Racing Schedule

- Maximum of seven (7) races are scheduled over two (2) days of racing.
- Minimum of three (3) races are required to constitute a series.
- One race may be discarded after four (4) completed races.
- Start times and number of races may be altered by a notice to competitors the afternoon prior, or at registration, depending on the forecast.
- If no races are completed on 24 April the first warning on 25 April will be 0900hrs.
- No warning signal shall be made after 1500hrs on Sunday 25 April, the last day of racing.

8 Measurements

It is the responsibility of the boats skipper to ensure that each boat complies with the International 420 Class rules.

9 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during registration at Woollahra Sailing Club and may be posted on the Woollahra Sailing Club website in the days prior to the regatta.

10 Racing Area

The racing area shall be on the waters of Sydney Harbour east of Fort Dennison.

11 Courses

The courses shall be as described in the sailing instructions, windward/leeward with target time per race of 40mins.

12 Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply.

13 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for dinghies placed first to third overall on Scratch and at the discretion of the NSW 420 Class Association. The presentation will be held at WSC as soon as practicable after completion of the last race on Sunday 25 April 2010.

14 Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.
