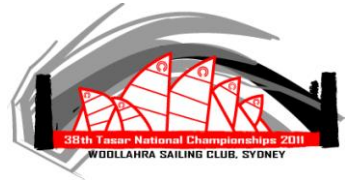




NOTICE OF RACE



The Australian Tasar Council as the national class association has appointed the Tasar Association of NSW in conjunction with Woollahra Sailing Club as the organizing authority to conduct the 38th Tasar Australian Championship on the waters of Sydney Harbour from 2nd January 2011 to 8th January 2011.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*.
- 1.2 The YA Special Regulations Part 2- Off the Beach Classes will apply.
- 1.3 The Rules of the World Tasar Class Association will apply. (see www.tasar.org)

2. Advertising

Advertising will be permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20- Advertising Code. The forward 25% of the hull is reserved by the regatta organising committee for display of advertising by event sponsor(s).

Boats intending to carry advertising should provide details of their sponsors on the entry form attached. Entrants shall be advised if they are in conflict with the event sponsor(s). Tobacco and related product advertising shall not be permitted.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Tasar Class that comply with the Rules of the World Tasar Class Association.
- 3.2 All skippers and crew shall be financial members of a Tasar Association which is a constituent of the World Tasar Council.
- 3.3 All skippers and crews shall be a member of a Yachting Australia affiliated sailing club. Presentation of a valid Yachting Australia Membership card at Registration is proof of current membership. International entrants will also need to provide proof of membership to their country's ISAF Member National Authority.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to be received by the organising authority no later than 24 December 2010. Alternatively entry may be made online at www.tasar.com.au from 1 August 2010.



3.5 Late entries will be accepted until 1400 hours on 1 January 2011.

4. Fees

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Early bird entry fee (prior to 15/10/2010)	AUS \$350
Entry fee (15/10/2010 to 24/12/2010)	AUS \$425
Late fee (after 24/12/2010)	AUS \$500

4.2 Entries are to be made via Direct Deposit to the TANSW account nominated on the official Entry Form and the Entry Form emailed to the TANSW Secretary or posted to:

4.3 The Entry Fee will include a regatta merchandise set for the skipper and crew plus 2 Presentation Dinner tickets.

5. Schedule of Events

5.1 Registration, measurement and boat inspection:-

Saturday 1st January 2011, between 1300 and 1700 hours; and

Sunday 2nd January 2011, between 0800 and 1100 hours

5.2 Regatta briefing/meetings:-

A competitors briefing will be held on Sunday 2nd January 2011, at 1200 hrs

5.3 Dates of racing:-

5.4 The warning signal for the Invitation race shall not be before 1400 hours.

5.5 There will be a maximum of three (3) races per day.



- 5.6 There shall be no warning signal after 1400 hours on the last day of racing.
- 5.7 In the event of more than 70 entries being received the race committee may be required to split the fleet. In the event of this, the arrangements will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

6. Measurement

- 6.1 Boat measurement and crew weigh-in will be in accordance with the Tasar Class Rules.
- 6.2 Boats may be inspected for safety equipment and measurement compliance at any time during the regatta.
- 6.3 It is the responsibility of each entrant to provide any supplementary weights necessary to ensure compliance with Tasar Class Rule 29. These must be presented at Registration. The Race Committee may reject at its discretion any form of supplementary weight it considers unsuitable.
- 6.4 Random measurement and compliance checks will be made throughout the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

7. Sailing Instructions

Printed copies of the sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the internet (www.woollahrasailingclub.org.au) after 24th December 2010.

8. Venue

The regatta will be conducted by Woollahra Sailing Club on the waters of Sydney Harbour East of Fort Dennison and South of the Sow and Pigs reef.

9. The Courses

The courses to be sailed shall consist of (approximately) equilateral triangles, trapezoid or windward returns as described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Penalty System

- 10.1 Application to Yachting Australia for appointment of a National Jury has been made and if approved decisions of the Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.



11. Scoring

- 11.1 Ten races, up to 3 per day, are scheduled and four are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When 1 to 4 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores.
- 11.3 When 5 to 8 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4 When 9 or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her two worst scores.

12. Support Boats

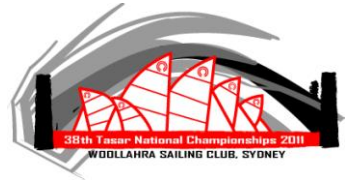
- 12.1 Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay at least 100 metres outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first division to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- 12.2 Support boats shall be marked by conspicuously displaying a Woollahra Sailing Club burgee, available at registration, at all times.
- 12.3 Support boats shall not signal to competitors by any means during a race.
- 12.4 Support boats are required to render assistance if requested to do so by the race committee or a competitor.

13. Radio Communications

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14. Venue Access

Access to, and boat storage at the venue will be available at no additional cost from 31 December 2010 to 10 January 2011 inclusive. Access to storage outside of these dates must be arranged on an individual basis with the venue.



15. Prizes

Prizes will be given as follows:

- Perpetual trophies for the Championship
- Masters (aggregate age 80-99 years)
- Grand Masters (aggregate age 100 years and over)
- Super Grand Masters (aggregate age 120 years and over)
- First Lady Helm
- First Junior Helm
- Other prizes may be awarded arbitrarily by the race organisers.

16. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Attention is drawn to Rule 4, Decision to race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of not less than AUD \$5,000,000 (recommended AUD \$10,000,000).

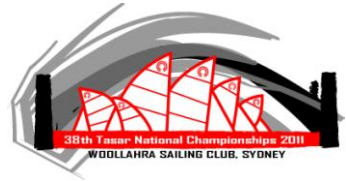
