NOTICE OF RACE

Winter Series 2010

Sundays from 23 May – 1 August

1 **Organising Authority and Venue**

The organising authority and venue for the series is Woollahra Sailing Club, Vickery Avenue, Rose Bay

2 **Rules**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2011) including the special regulations and prescriptions of Yachting Australia.

3 **Alterations of Racing Rules**

The racing rules will be modified in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

Rule 44.1, taking a Penalty is altered to read: "A boat that may have broken a rule of part 2 while racing may take a penalty at the time of her incident. Her penalty shall be a One Turn Penalty".

4 **Eligibility and Entry**

4.1 The series is open to all members of Woollahra Sailing Club and members of other clubs affiliated to Yachting Australia.

4.2 Eligible sailors can enter on the attached Entry Form which shall be lodged with:

Entries may be received prior to 23 May or on any day of the series provided that a completed entry form is lodged before the warning signal of the first race an entrant intends to start.

5 **Classes to be Sailed**

5.1 The following Divisions will be sailed for the series:

Division 1-	Classes with asymmetrical spinnaker and foiling moths.
Division 2-	Classes other than those in Division 1
Division 3-	Recognised junior and intermediate classes

6 Fees

- 6.1 Series entry is \$10 per person for Woollahra Sailing Club members or \$25 per person for members of other clubs.
- 6.2 Woollahra Sailing Club members may elect not to pay entry but will only be eligible for series trophies and not for any other prizes that may be offered.

7 Schedule of Events

- 7.1 Racing will take place each Sunday from the 23rd May until the 1st August with the exception of Sunday 13th of June which will be a lay day for this series.
- 7.2 There will be two scheduled races per Division on each day of racing.
- 7.3 The first warning signal for each day shall be no earlier than 0945hrs and no race shall be started after 1200hrs.

8 Measurements

It is the responsibility of the boats skipper to ensure that each boat complies with its relevant classes measurement rules.

8 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during registration at Woollahra Sailing Club and on the Woollahra Sailing Club website from 22 May.

10 Racing Area

The racing area shall be on the waters of Sydney Harbour, South of the Sow and Pigs Reef and East the harbour bridge.

11 Courses

The courses shall be described in the sailing instructions and may be windward/leeward, triangular or long harbour course.

12 Scoring

12.1 The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply. A minimum of four starters is required to constitute a race.

12.2 Boats will be handicapped through the series using Back Calculated Yardsticks.

13 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each Division overall and at the discretion of the race committee at the completion of each days racing. Prizes may also be awarded for Class placings for classes with 8 or more entrants.
